MAXIMUM RETAIL PUMP PRICES OF PETROLEUM

In accordance with Legal Notice No.196, The Energy (Petroleum Pricing) Regulations, 2010, the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) has calculated the maximum retail pump prices of petroleum products which will be in force from 15th January to 14th February 2011.

During December 2010, the international prices of crude oil and refined petroleum products continued on an upward trend which started in July 2010. The Free On Board price for Murban crude oil lifted during December 2010 was posted at US Dollars 91.85 per barrel, an increase of 7% from US Dollars 85.65 per barrel in November 2010.

The average landed cost of super petrol increased by 8% from US Dollars 834 per metric ton in November to US Dollars 898 per metric ton. Over the same period the average landed costs of Diesel increased by 6% from US dollars 766 per ton to US Dollars 815 while the average landed costs of kerosene increased by 6% from US dollars 821 per ton in November 2010 to US Dollars 871 per ton in December.

When the impacts of the above changes are incorporated in the formula for calculating pump prices the overall effect is an average increase of less than 2% of the Mombasa maximum retail prices from the prices announced last month. The increases for the individual products as at Mombasa are as follows:

Super Petrol: Kenya shillings 1.45per litre.
Regular Petrol: Kenya shillings 2.59per litre.
Kerosene: Kenya shillings 1.53 per litre.
Diesel: Kenya shillings 1.08 per litre.
